No candidate will be allowed entry into the examination hall ten minutes after commencement of the examination.


The Question Papers of GDCE will be bilingual, i.e. in Hindi and English.

Admit cards for the written examination are being despatched to the eligible candidates at the address for correspondence furnished by them in their application forms. Few candidates whose names were included in rejected lists circulated vide this office letter of even no. dated 07.01.2016, have been found eligible to appear in the examination on further scrutiny of their applications. Their names have been displayed on the official website of RRC/GHY and admit cards are being issued to them. In case any candidate does not receive the admit card by 03.07.2016, he/she should collect duplicate admit card from the office of RRC/GHY (Station Colony, Pan Bazar, Guwahati-781001) between 10.00hrs. to 17.00 hrs. on 04.07.2016. The candidates should carry valid Railway Identity Card which will be checked along with admit cards on the date of written examination.
